It's been several years since SEMBS last visited, and many changes have taken place since Belle Isle became a Michigan State Park: the Anna Scripps Whitcomb Conservatory was reopened this summer following ten months of renovations to the greenhouse structure, and the perennial garden area is being completely re-designed, with a grand reopening scheduled for the fall of 2020; we may get a sneak peek at the outdoor garden construction as well.

In the past, bromeliads were a strong presence in the tropical house. Our members had contributed many plants to the Belle Isle collection over the years, and in the past we've had numerous meetings to work on maintaining the bromeliads. This meeting is an opportunity to renew a working relationship with the garden staff at the conservatory.
